

Dear First Grade Families,

We are off to a great start! It is my goal to keep you informed about your child's behavior and to keep the lines of communication open. I will be sending home a daily behavior chart in your child's binder. In our classroom we have a clip chart to monitor our behavior. Students have their number on a clothespin and can move up or down the clip chart. If I see a student showing exceptional behavior I will tell them to move their clothespin up. If a child is not behaving as expected, they will move their clothespin down. The best thing about this system is students can move down, but then have a chance to go back up throughout the day. Each day your child will color in the circle based on how their day ended. Below you will see what each color stands for. All students start the day on green. Please know that my expectation is for the students to stay on green as it shows positive behavior all day. Many students will end the day on green and that is perfect!

Pink - Outstanding!

Purple - Great Job!

Blue - Good Day!

Green - Ready to Learn

Yellow - Think About It (a warning)

Orange - Teacher's Choice of Consequence

Red - Parent Contact

Please put your initials in the box each night. We are trying to get in this routine so students will be used to it when they get a planner in second grade. All mail will now come home in the finder daily with the behavior chart. If you have any questions about this, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.
